Comedy / Romance.

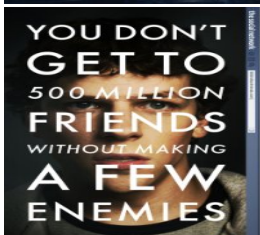
A ladiesman keeps himself and his team in work by breaking up "unsuitable" romances for money ----until he meets his match!
